أتشرف بإعلامكم أنني عقدت يوم 28 مارس 2017، جلسة عمل مع وفد من جامعة Beijing Institute of Technology (BIT) تترأسه السيدة Wang Ying، مديرة شؤون الطلبة الأجانب بهذه الجامعة.

وتعتبر جامعة BIT من أهم المؤسسات الجامعية الصينية وتم اختيارها من بين أشهر 10 جامعات صينية في العالم حيث يزاول قرابة 2000 طالب أجنبي سنويا دراستهم في مختلف الاختصاصات من بين مجموع 30 ألف. كما تم تصنيفها مؤخرا من بين أكثر 10 الجامعات في الصين إنفاقا في مجال الدراسات والبحوث العلمية والتي تبلغ سنويا أكثر 150 مليون أورو. وهي جامعة متعددة الاختصاصات وتعرف بجودة برامجها التعليمية خاصة في مجال الهندسة الميكانيكية وهندسة المعلومات والاتصال وعلوم الفضاء والكيمياء وتكنولوجيا وعلوم الحاسوب والعلوم القانونية.

المنح الجامعية التي ستوفرها الجامعة الصينية:

أفاد السيدة Wang بأن جامعة BIT ستوفر بالتنسيق مع مجلس المنح الجامعية الصيني 3 منح حكومية إضافية لفائدة طلبة الماجستير والدكتوراه التونسيين بعنوان السنة الجامعية 2017-2018. ويتحمل الجانب الصيني مصاريف الدراسة والإقامة والإعاشة في حين يتحمل الطرف التونسي مصاريف

التنقل الدولي. وحددت آخر الآجال لتقديم الترشيحات في منتصف شهر أفريل 2017 (تجدون رفقته وثائق تفسيرية حول هذه المنح).

BIT Scholarship for International Students
From the Embassy of the Republic of Tunisia
2017-2018

Beijing Institute of Technology (BIT) is offering up to 2 CSC (China Scholarship Council) scholarships for students from the leading universities in Tunisia to pursue Master or PhD degree programs in BIT. BIT entrusts the Embassy of the Republic of Tunisia in China to operate the scholarship. The Embassy will select the candidates from the Tunisian universities and recommend them to BIT.

➤ **Overview**

The CSC scholarship covers the tuition fee, accommodation, comprehensive medical insurance and the monthly living allowance (CNY 3,000 for masters and CNY 3,500 for PhDs). The international air fare is not covered. The scholarship will be offered to the students during their stay at Beijing Institute of Technology for the period of the Master programs (2 years) and PhD programs (4 years).

➤ **CSC scholarship application:** From January 1st to April 10th, 2017

➤ **Admission**

1. For pre-admitted candidates who have paid the application fee and the prepaid tuition, we will email you the pre-admission notice and the commitment form in March or April and submit your application documents to the CSC for its final approval.
2. The final decision will be announced by CSC at the end of June each year and BIT will announce the result of successful candidates upon the receipt of the CSC's final decision.
3. BIT will send the formal admission letter and visa application form (JW201 Form) by post in July.

➤ **CSC scholarship application: From January 1st to March 31st, 2017**

- Step 1- Applicants should contact the Embassy in China to get the recommendation. Individual application is not accepted and registered students who are also CSC scholarship holders are not eligible for this program.
- Step 2 - After the International Office sends BIT the nomination letter, recommended candidates should register on <http://www.campuschina.org/> and click **Application online for International students**. The program category is Type B. The Agent No. of BIT is 10007. Please fill out all required areas and submit it online. Then download the systematically-generated CSC application form to check **your CSC serial number** in the format like 16XXXXXXX which is located in the bottom left corner of the form.
- Step 3- Recommended candidates please go to <http://isc.bit.edu.cn/> and choose schools to find the contact information about the BIT advisors. Please inform the advisor of your CSC serial number so that he or she can complete the Recommendation Form which is a **MUST** for both master and PhD candidates.
- Step 4- Please log onto the website of <http://apply.isc.bit.edu.cn> and register with the designated username "CSCserial number" (For example: CSC16XXXXXXX, and it's CSC not csc) and then upload the following required ten documents for review:

- CSC application form;
- Certified master or bachelor degree certificate (English version) for graduates/Certificate of schooling for registered students;
- Certified transcripts of the highest degree;
- Curriculum Vitae;
- Personal Statement indicating the purpose of study, preferred research work or experience and academic background;
- Two recommendation letters by home university professors;
- Recommendation Form from BIT advisors;
- Front page of the passport;
- Physical Examination Record for Foreigner (<http://isc.bit.edu.cn/show.aspx?id=137&cid=119>);
- For applicants of English-taught master majors, the Certificate of Proficiency in English or letter on the language of instruction is needed. For the info of such majors, please check our 2017 admission book at <http://isc.bit.edu.cn/show.aspx?id=625&cid=40>.) For applicants of Chinese-taught majors, the HSK 4 certificate or other relevant certificates is needed.

- Step 5- Please pay the application fee of 600 CNY (non-refundable) directly online in a week if you pass the first review and pay the prepaid tuition (3,000 CNY for master candidates and 3,500 CNY for Ph.D. candidates) (refundable after the September registration) in a week if you pass the second review. Please note that failing to pay the fee before the deadline will be considered as giving up the application.

➤ **Admission**

1. For pre-admitted candidates who have paid the application fee and the prepaid tuition, we will email you the pre-admission notice and the commitment form in March or April and submit your application documents to the CSC for its final approval.
2. The final decision will be announced by CSC at the end of June each year and BIT will announce the result of successful candidates upon the receipt of the CSC's final decision.
3. BIT will send the formal admission letter and visa application form (JW201 Form) by post in July.
